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PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE:

Work before Play

I thought I would be writing this newsletter on the importance of play. With the ski hill opening on November 29th and heaps of snow on the ground, it seemed like reflecting on the importance of play was the way to go.

However, I want all learners (and hopefully their parents) to take a moment to consider the learning students need to accomplish before the school year ends. The grade K to 9 students needs to consider what pace they should be completing their course work at.

Students need to complete 8 courses per year in order to graduate at the expected time. It is important that the K to 9 students consider, each year builds upon the last and missed school work in one year will compound problems the next.

Consider KDS has 173 days of instruction in a year and if a student is taking two courses at a time, two courses should be completed every 43 days of school. Below is what that looks like on a calendar.

Completion of first two courses: November 7 Completion of second two courses: January 23 Completion of third set of courses: April 17

Final two courses: June 26

These dates are not an exact science, it will differ for different students. Some will want to move quickly in the fall because they focus on skiing in the winter, others are busy in the fall and dedicate more time to school in the winter. Teachers also need time for assessing and communicating student learning. What these dates do is give students and parents a guidepost for expected pacing of course completion.

I love to play, and I think it is a highlight of life. Play is great, but it is even better when you play after gaining a sense of accomplishment for the hard work you put in before taking the time to play.




